

AVTEC CAMPUS FACILITIES

Over the past 30 years, AVTEC campus facilities have expanded to encompass three distinct areas within the City of Seward and expanded to include one campus in Anchorage. In recent years, AVTEC has acquired more buildings and land to meet the employment and training needs of Alaska's business and industrial community. The facilities, classes, training, and activities within each campus area are distinct as well.

Seward Campus



At the western edge of central Seward, the **First Lake Campus** has three buildings located on it. The First Lake Facility, located at 809 Second Avenue, is 32,142 sq. ft. and houses AVTEC's Administrative offices, Admissions and Financial Aid, Counselors, Business & Office Technology program, Information Technology program, Web Development Technology program, general academic classes provided by Learning Resources Department and the Alaska Maritime Training Center. Technology building is a 6,720 sq. ft. building, located at 709 Second Avenue and it houses Facility Maintenance/Construction Trades and Related Studies. The main number to this facility is (907) 224-6178. The Connected Education Center, located at 703 Second Avenue, houses the distance delivery classrooms, broadcast rooms and offices. In the midst of downtown Seward, the **Student Life Campus** encompasses dormitory and apartment housing for AVTEC students, The Alaska Culinary Academy and cafeteria, community services and classes for Adult Basic Education, GED and other Learning Resources programs, library, library computer lab and the Student Service Center. The Student Service Center building is 30,926 sq. ft. and is located at 519 Fourth Avenue. The Alaska Culinary Academy is 10,371 sq. ft. and is located at 518 Third Avenue. At the northern industrial end of town, the **Applied Technologies Campus** consists of three buildings. The Applied Technologies Campus, located at 1916 Leirer Road is 30,278 sq. ft. and holds shop and classroom buildings for AVTEC's Automotive Technology, Diesel and Heavy Equipment Technologies, and Welding. The second building, a 9,058 sq. ft. building, holds shop and classrooms for the Industrial Electricity program. The third building, Port Avenue facility, located at 709 Second Avenue is 7,200 sq. ft. and hosts the Plumbing & Heating program and Power

AVTEC was awarded a \$2 million federal Economic Development Administration grant to construct a **Maritime Safety Training Campus** in Seward. This 4,800 square foot facility will expand AVTEC's capabilities and allow them to train 114 mariners per year to meet a critical high demand for high growth jobs in the transportation industry. A campus on the east side of Resurrection Bay, located on 7 acres under a 30 year lease from the City of Seward, currently houses a training lifeboat and davits and can accommodate additional classroom space and fire fighting training activity areas. The construction on this facility should begin in the Spring/Summer of 2009.

Anchorage Campus

The Allied Health Department is located at the AVTEC **Anchorage Campus**. This campus is located in the Muldoon Mall in east Anchorage at 1251 Muldoon Road, Suite 113 and is 5,080 sq. ft. The main phone number is (907) 334-2230. The Certified Nurse Assistant program and Licensed Practical Nurse program are held at this campus. This campus houses three classrooms, two clinical labs, staff offices and lobby.
